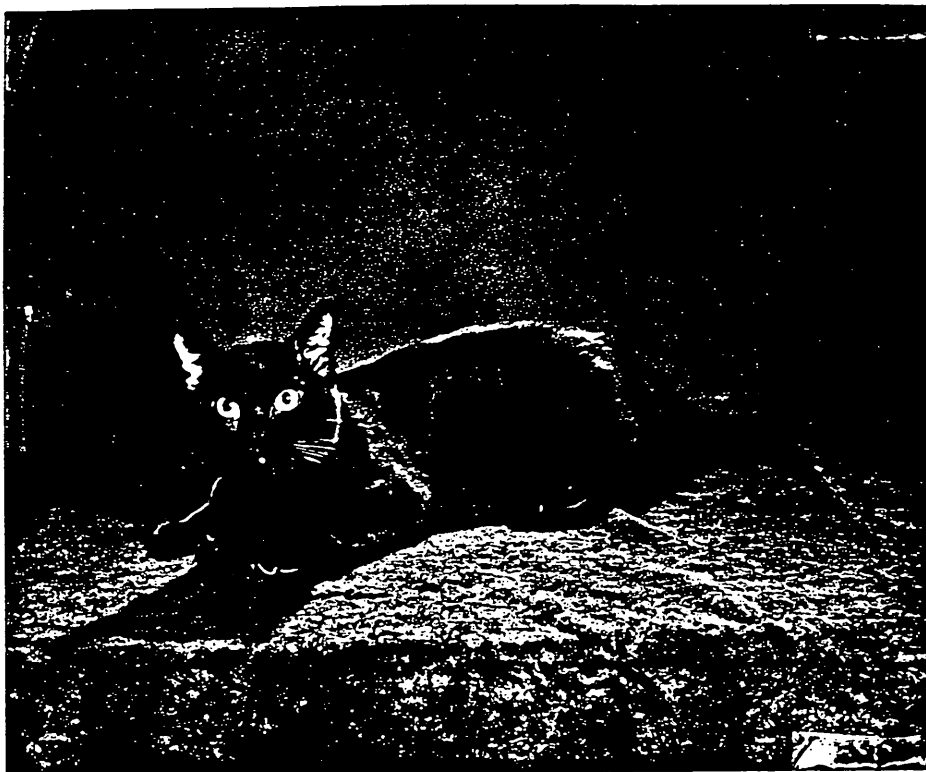

**COVER STORY:**

"Tank traveled 20 hours from Vancouver to Amsterdam and both ways came purring out of his cage, completely unimpressed with it all. In 4 weeks there, he bred 5 females and the result was enormous...1 x 10 kittens, 3 x 9 kittens and one litter of 8 for a total of 45 healthy kittens...There were no white lockets, head defects, barring or any other major faults like tail faults, etc. On the trip to Holland, a daughter of his (MAYA) went with him to a breeder there. It is just as difficult to become a champion there, in FIFE, as it is to grand here. If your cat is best sable Burm 3 times, and score at least 92 of the 100 points given in the standard, you receive a certificate called CAC. When you have three of those certificates, your cat's a champion.

Maya went to 3 FIFE shows (1,100, 1,200 and 1,500 cats competing respectively) and was BEST Burmese every time. Remember, FIFE recognizes the Blue, Platinum, Champaigne, Red, Cream and Tortie in the Burmese Breed. The smallest Burm class was 35, and the biggest 51!!

Maya also went up for BEST IN SHOW in all three shows, but lost to an Abby every time.

In the meantime, Tank is doing fine. He is the easiest male we have ever had. He does not spray, nor did he in his European trip...so all in all Tank is producing litters like crazy and his litters are doing very well in TICA shows (TICA is by far the biggest registry body here in the Northwest Region), and he is easy to keep and a very loving stud...so who can ask for more."

## Grooming the **BURMESE**

The excellent appearance of any cat is based first on good breeding, next on good nutrition and maintenance, and finally on good grooming. Probably the most distinguished feature of the Burmese is the beautiful shiny sable-brown coat. That healthy shine doesn't just come out of a bottle the day before a show. In addition to good protein, the diet should be rich in vitamins, especially Vitamin-E, and fatty substances such as egg-yolks. My cats get a half of a raw egg-yolk (on the average) per day, and a high-quality vitamin supplement which contains a good amount of Brewers Yeast.

In terms of the actual grooming process, Burmese of course don't require the amount of daily attention that the Longhairs do. A weekly brushing with a rubber brush is enough to get rid of the dead hairs in the coat. Stud-tail problems are controlled by a weekly treatment of either Fullers Earth or cornstarch, applied with an oldtoothbrush. After thoroughly rubbing it in, the excess amount is removed with a fine-toothed comb. For those cats being actively shown, the weekly "once-over" should include the plucking of those pesky white hairs around the neck and shoulder.

I bathe my cats on Thursday before the show, using either Johnson's Baby Shampoo or Vidal Sassoon Extra Gentle Shampoo followed by a conditioner. (I may skip a week if the cat was bathed the week before and still looks great.) For those cats with unusually greasy coats, I use Lambert-Kay's Black Out shampoo with no conditioner. It takes some experimentation to find the right combination for each cat -- it's really surprising how variable the coat texture and body can be on a Burm! For those with a dry coat, the best conditioner I've found is Wella Balsam Conditioner. For those with a little oilier coat, I use Almay's Non-Oily Conditioner. Never leave the conditioner on longer than 20-30 seconds - the coat will get too oily - and NEVER, NEVER use a conditioner

that's labelled "for extra body". The last thing you want is to make the coat feel thicker! In my opinion, the perfect Burmese coat, and the objective of all this, is thin, so close-lying that it seems to be an extension of the skin, very shiny and very soft and silky. In fact, it should be so silky, (downright slippery) that when you put your hand on the cat's back, your hand should slide off on it's own.

After a thorough rinsing, towel-dry the cat, and comb the fur with a fine-toothed flea comb. This ensures that all the fur is lying in the right direction during the drying process. Let the cat dry in a warm room (I usually turn on a portable space heater).

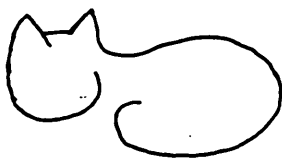
The condition of the coat should be re-checked on Friday. If you've misjudged the amount of conditioner and the coat looks or feels too greasy (hairs clumping together), rebathe the cat in Black Out shampoo with no conditioner. If the coat feels too dry, spray a small amount of spray-on conditioner such as Clairol's Spray-On Creme Rinse on the flat side of a rubber brush. Brush the fur against the grain to work in the conditioner, then brush the way the fur lays, from head to tail, for a few minutes. All show-goers should get a good five-minute brushing with the flat side of the rubber brush on Friday evening in any case.

What about the show itself? I often see breeders spraying various kinds of aerosol grooming sprays on Burms. In my experience, anything sprayed on top of the coat at this point makes it feel a bit sticky and certainly less silky. I think the Burm coat is at its best when it's absolutely spanking clean. If there are still white hairs left, by all means go after those before the first ring. Other than that, I check the eyes and wipe them gently with a soft tissue if necessary. Then I comb the coat again with a fine-toothed flea comb so that the hairs all lie in the same direction. If there is any dust or a few specs of dandruff, I gently stroke an anti-static cloth ("Cling-Free" or "Bounce") over the coat and blow or shake the specs off. Finally, I give the coat several strokes with a chamois, and off we go into the ring.

Occasionally a grease emergency will arise, such as your cat rolling in the fried chicken you brought in and are sharing with him (I speak from personal experience). Thanks to Carol Bulotta (Windflower Cattery, Pittsburgh), I've found that the best grease-cutter is Vodka, applied to the coat with a damp cloth and rubbed in vigorously, followed by a thorough brushing with a rubber brush. Carrying Vodka in your show kit has other beneficial uses, of course. It's wonderfully soothing when applied to the owner after a particularly ridiculous judging.

Finally, remember that judges do indeed notice how a cat is presented. A well groomed Burmese sparkles, is harder to ignore by the judge, and shows your pride in your cat.

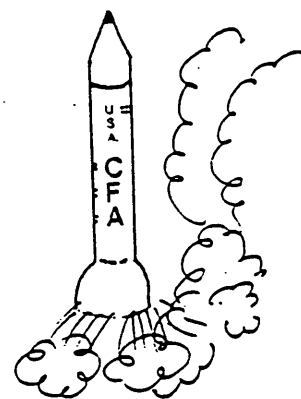
