The National Alliance of Burmese Breeders, Inc. (NABB) is a breed club affiliated with the Cat Fancier's Association (CFA) with the objective of furthering the status, health and wellbeing of the pedigree Burmese cat. The Constitution of the club defines two classes of membership: Full Member and Associate Member. The membership year starts on March 1. Membership dues are payable starting in March, prior to the start of the membership year. Any member whose dues are not received by April 15 shall be dropped from membership. New members joining after December 1st shall be considered paid for the following year. *Membership dues or Subscription fees are not refundable*

Full member – a person over the age of 16, who has either bred or registered with CFA at least one litter of Burmese or has shown a Burmese cat in a CFA show. Full members have voting privileges and may hold office. Full members must provide a copy of a CFA litter registration or a copy of a show catalog indicating the exhibition of a Burmese (owned or formally leased) in a CFA show. Requirements for Full Membership are shown on the NABB website at <http://www.burmesecat.org/join.html>. Full members who are breeders are required to abide by NABB's Code of Conduct, and must include a signed copy of the Code of Conduct.

Associate Member – person who is interested in the objectives of NABB. These members do not have voting privileges. Associate members are provided an electronic copy of the newsletter, but may order printed copies.

A listing in the NABB Breeder Directory is available for Full member who are breeders. Membership no longer includes printed newsletters. You can now subscribe to the printed newsletter or select a specific one to receive each year (i.e. CFA Annual Awards NL). Overseas members and Associate Members may also subscribe to get the printed newsletters. Any member may order a printed copy of any individual newsletter issue for \$7, but overseas members will be required to pay the international postage in addition. For newsletter copies, please contact our Secretary.

# NATIONAL ALLIANCE OF BURMESE BREEDERS

## NABB Code of Conduct

The National Alliance of Burmese Breeders, NABB, is dedicated to the promotion and preservation of the Burmese breed and all cats. NABB encourages excellence among its members in breeding practices. NABB and its members believe that the Burmese breed is one to be respected and cherished and that cats and kittens should be kept in safe, caring and loving homes. NABB believes that members should provide for the health and welfare of the breed through respect and knowledge. NABB requires any member that breeds Burmese cats to uphold the highest of standards for their breeding programs and must meet and maintain the NABB Code Of Conduct.

NABB members:

- Shall uphold the CFA Code of Ethics.
- Shall not sell, supply or offer cats or kittens to pet shops, retail pet stores, pet brokers, pet wholesalers, shelters, research laboratories or any organization that uses animals for commercial or experimental purposes.
- Shall keep cats in clean and sanitary conditions that conform to the minimum requirements of the CFA Cattery of Excellence criteria. Cats shall be kept under the regular care of a licensed veterinarian, and be properly immunized.
- Shall not knowingly place or sell ill or defective cats or kittens without informed consent of the buyer/new owner.
- Shall offer kittens for sale or transfer at no less than 12 weeks of age and having received at least one vaccination for rhinotracheitis, calici virus and feline distemper. Members shall offer a health guarantee that assures new owners that the kitten is free from contagious diseases, parasites and fungus. All pet quality cats and kittens shall be sold with spay/neuter agreements or altered prior to sale or placement.
- Are encouraged to use clear, concise written contracts to document the sale or lease of Burmese kittens and cats, or the arrangement for stud service.
- Shall maintain good sportsmanship at all events and competitions.
- Shall maintain honesty and integrity when entering into contracts with other breeders. Contract requirements and agreements shall be honored at all times.
- Shall maintain accurate records and pedigrees.

As a member of NABB and breeder of Burmese registered by the Cat Fancier's Association, I agree to uphold this Code of Conduct of the club. Failure to meet and maintain these ethics may result in expulsion from the club or rejection of application for membership.
